Copies of the proposed Local Law #6 of 2018 are on file at the Office of the Village Clerk-Treasurer and may be inspected during regular business hours. Parties may appear and comment at the hearing in person or by agent.

Environmental Review pursuant to the State Environmental Quality Review Act shall be conducted incidental to the foregoing. This Action May be deemed a Type II or Unlisted Action, and or may be limited to a review scheme established by an authorized state or federal agency, and which determination, if it can, shall be made during the Regular meeting of the Board to take place following the within public hearing. If determined to be an Unlisted Action, it will be proposed by the Village Board to conduct an uncoordinated review acting as Lead Agency and public comment may be submitted verbally by giving testimony at the public hearing or by written submission addressed to the Village Clerk-Treasurer and received at the Village Offices not later than one day prior to the public hearing and regular meeting date. The Boards decision may also be deferred and the hearing extended for further written comments in the Boards sole discretion

Review on such date shall include consideration of whether or not the action is subject to GML 239-m or any other outside agency review, and if so whether it shall be determined the application be referred to County Planning for such purpose.

It is the Villages affirmative and published policy to encourage and protect the rights of the disabled to access local government and actively participate at the public hearing, and as may be permitted, if at all, at the Regular Meeting following, if so desired. Accordingly, those desiring such access and suffering a disability preventing or restricting same should if at all possible, contact the Village Clerks office not later than two days prior to such date. The Village will endeavor to ensure reasonable access is provided and regardless of if and when any such notice and request was made and received. In addition, the Village does have an affirmative appeal/review process those not granted reasonable access may pursue. The Village Administrator, James Lynch, serves as the investigating, enforcing and/or similar person having been duly appointed by the Village Board at its annual Organizational meeting, and specifically as a hearing and appeals officer under Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act (similar substantively to the ADA. Further information may be read at or obtained, the latter pursuant to a FOIL request if so desired or directed, by the Clerk-Treasurer.
